Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) is a school-wide design to prevent and respond to school and classroom discipline problems. PBIS supports the Timpview staff to teach and promote positive behavior in students.

Timpview's focus in using PBIS is to teach appropriate behaviors in all settings, intervene when behavior expectations are not met and recognize student achievement. The purpose of PBIS is to create an environment where everyone feels welcome, promote unity, and maximize learning.
